Project Narrative:

As part of our attempt to give back and thank a veteran who has voluntarily served our country by making both personal, emotional and physical sacrifices to keep America safe and free, American Trademark Construction Services (ATCS) is committed to building and donating a new home for a deserving veteran with disabilities that limit or inhibit him or her from living their life as normal as possible. After a long process, we have narrowed our search to a suitable candidate for this home and were able to begin the building process in late 2016.

To accomplish our goal, ATCS has partnered with "Operation Finally Home", a charitable organization specifically established to promote, organize and document charitable donations for construction of new homes for disabled veterans (see enclosed brochure). We are seeking assistance from contractors/material suppliers who have the resources to help us supply the labor and material required to build & furnish a home this family will be able to live in for years to come. We want to give them the opportunity and resources they need to live a comfortable life by reducing their physical and financial stress.

1. What ATCS is offering:

- To build and donate a new double home, totally handicap accessible to meet the needs of the veteran.
- To help financially, the veteran can live in one half of the double and rent the other half for income to supplement disability income and benefits.
- Home will be located on McSmith Drive in Butler Township, just south of Vandalia. This residential area is across the street from Smith Middle School and close to a bus stop, shopping, restaurants, doctors, hospital and typical amenities desired in close proximity to a residential neighborhood.

2. Timeline:

- ATCS considers the construction of a new home for a disabled veteran top priority.
- ATCS has set aside \$250,000 in a trust account to accomplish this goal in 2017.

In summary, ATCS is in need of your assistance to help us “Give Back” to a veteran who has served our country and given all they could to keep America safe and free. Their sacrifices are often overlooked and unnoticed by those who take our freedom and abundance for granted. It is our turn to do something for them!
